The pope wanted to honor St. Francis of Assisi, an admirer of nature and a servant to the poor and destitute. St. Francis of Assisi was born the son of a rich cloth merchant. But he lived in rags among beggars at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome.

*He is a very humble man.

*He uses public transportation every day.

*The pontiff broke with tradition by refusing to use a platform to elevate himself above the cardinals standing with him as he was introduced to the world as Pope Francis.

*As archbishop he also

chose to live in an apartment instead of the archbishop's palace, passed on a chauffeured limousine and cooked his own meals.

Religious Education


This year Religious Education has extended the dates of the program. We are starting on September 15th and going through the Easter Season, ending on May 18, 2014.
