The ChristLife series is a three-step evangelization process that is changing lives and transforming parishes. The first year of the series is entitled “Discovering Christ” which is a seven-week experience that invites you to hear the Good News and personally encounter Jesus Christ. It is this first part of the series that our parish is going to be doing. We are in the beginning stages of putting the program together. I have heard great things about this program from the pastors in this diocese that have started it. Members of our committees will be gathering at the end of this month for an informational meeting.

Discovering Christ consists of seven weekly sessions and a retreat day. The weekly sessions include four components: a meal, prayer time, a video teaching, and small group discussion. Our parish does great at preparing, serving and enjoying meals. I eagerly look forward to this part of the program. Sharing a meal provides a great atmosphere for getting to know each other. Prayer is also an important part of our parish and is done well here. I also look forward to our time of prayer. I have spent most of my life learning, whether it be in school, at presentations and most always through experiences. I have seen great things come from small group discussions because of the spirituality of the participants.

The other two parts of the ChristLife program include, “Following Christ”, a seven-week journey that explores and encourages Catholic discipleship. The third program in the series is entitled, “Sharing Christ, a seven-week mission that trains Catholics to share Jesus Christ with others and invite them to be part of the Church.
