## **Day of Penance and Mercy**

During the November 1940 World War II blitz in England, Coventry Cathedral was destroyed. Workmen picking through the rubble found a large number of nails from the Middle Ages. The nails were gathered up, fashioned into crosses and plated with silver. One cross of nails was set up on an altar in the ruins of the old cathedral, Behind it is a large, charred cross, and inscribed on the wall behind that are the words, "Father, forgive." Many little crosses made of those nails have since been sent to churches in other countries that had engaged in World War II. Thousands upon thousands of picture postcards depicting the Coventry Cross of Nails and the words, "Father, forgive" have been distributed all over the world. The Coventry Cross of Nails has become for many a symbol of forgiveness, reconciliation and peace.

This weekend we reach the halfway point of Lent as we journey to the cross leading to the Resurrection at Easter. Part of that journey is to seek forgiveness from the Lord. This Tuesday March 14, there will be such an opportunity, the Day of Penance and Mercy. We will be at St. Mary's from 12:00 to 3:00 that day then will be at St. Patrick's from 3:00 to 7:00 for private confessions. In order to help you with this Day of Penance and Mercy there will be materials available at both churches, including, an examination of conscience, a prayer card with the act of contrition, and other helpful resources.

According to Bishop Matano, "Sadly, many Catholics do not participate in this profound experience of God's boundless care for us, and others do so only occasionally. Yet our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has repeatedly reminded us that we are a Church of sinners and that each of us benefits from God's mercy. This is a wonderful opportunity during the Lenten season to experience the healing power of the Sacrament and to truly understand the old adage, 'Confession is good for the soul,'"

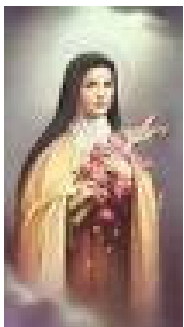
## Parish Lenten Series
