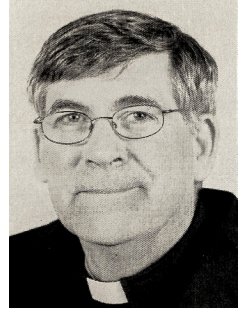

- This calls us to social justice to service those in need and to work together for God and one another



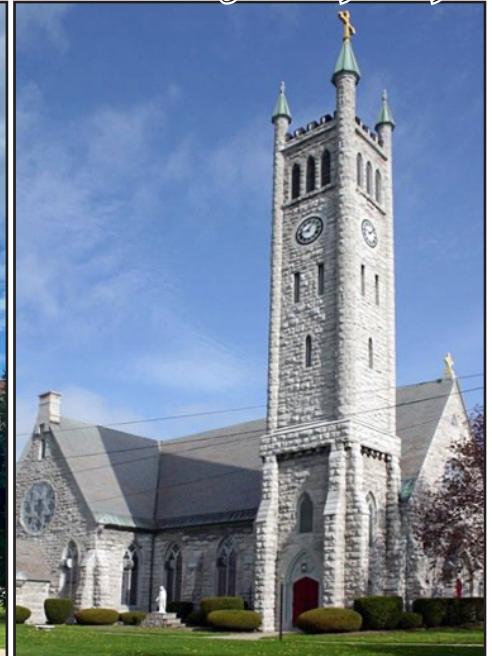

REJOICE, REJOICE, REJOICE

On behalf of the staff of St. Francis and St. Clare parish, I would like to wish you all a blessed Easter. Lent was a time to repent; Easter is a time to rejoice. Congratulations to the newly baptized who also received Eucharist and Confirmation last night at the Easter Vigil. Easter is about Baptism, Resurrection, and new life.

Dear Parishioners of Saint Francis and Saint Clare Parish,

Happy Easter! Easter brings in spring and so much more! When Easter comes, we realize that Spring has come, First Communion and Confirmation are just around the corner, and baby animals are about to be everywhere. All of these things have to do with new life. Of course, spring means new life because of all the budding plants, little flowers, sprouting crops, and baby animals. First Communion is the most amazing experience we will ever have, and the best part is that we can experience it over and over without ever losing the joy of receiving it. It's like receiving the present you've always wanted over and over again. I have always been so thankful that I could come back to church every week. I hope that I never lose the joy of receiving the Eucharist. I hope you never lose it either. If you have, maybe this season of Easter is a time to try to rekindle the Fire of the Holy Spirit in your heart. Once you are baptized, the Holy Spirit will never leave you. There is always time to come back to God. There is endless time in heaven. Thus, God always has time for us. Although we can't comprehend it, we need to recognize that there are things God can do that we will never understand. He loves us all and He will do anything to get the lost sheep back. The next wonderful sacrament that will be coming up is Confirmation. Confirmation is a beautiful gift, for those who wish to receive it. The word confirm means that you are affirming something is true. In Confirmation, we confirm that we believe the truths of the Catholic Church. We renew our Baptismal vows. We also confirm that we truly want to be Catholics all the rest of our lives. Being Catholic means going to Mass every week, so that we can receive the greatest Gift God gave us: the Eucharist. It also means being a light to those in the world around us. Maybe you're good at evangelizing, or maybe you're compassionate. Maybe you are always spreading joy to those around you, and when someone asks why, you attribute it to God. Maybe you like to defend what is right or to study our faith to a great extent. Or maybe, you just love to pray. All of these are talents that people have. There are countless more. In Confirmation, we receive the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. These strengthen the gifts that God gave us at birth. They can help you discover gifts you've never had, or never imagined you would have. I will write again about each of these sacraments individually and about spiritual gifts. I hope that you left church today with joy in your heart because Jesus is Risen, giving you the joy that can never be extinguished. We know what waits for us in heaven, Our Lord Jesus Christ. 
