- This calls us to social justice to service those in need and to work together for God and one another



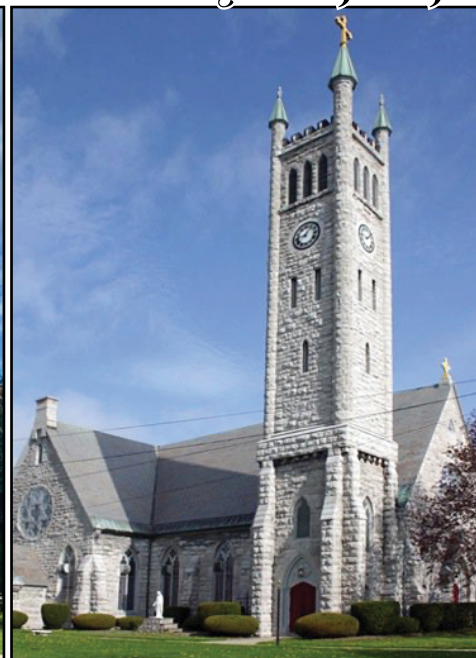

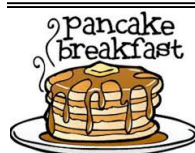

The Feast of Divine Mercy

On the Second Sunday of Easter of the Jubilee Year 2000, at the Mass for the canonization of St. Faustina Kowalska, Pope John Paul II proclaimed to the world that "from now on throughout the Church this Sunday will be called Divine Mercy Sunday." On the Second Sunday of Easter, the responsorial psalm and Gospel for Cycles A, B and C center on the theme of mercy. In Psalm 118 we sing three times, "His mercy endures forever." The Gospel, from John 20:19-31, begins with the risen Christ appearing to the apostles on Easter night. Jesus calms his disciples by saying and giving them "Peace." He shows them the scars of his Passion, his wounded hands and side. His glorified body retains the evidence of his saving work through his suffering, death and resurrection.

This year we will have a Divine Mercy celebration next Sunday at St. Mary's starting with Eucharistic Exposition at 1:00pm. Individual Reconciliation to follow. At 2:45pm the Hour of Great Mercy Devotions will begin (this includes Divine Mercy Praises & the Chaplet of Divine Mercy). The afternoon concludes with the Rite of Eucharistic Benediction.

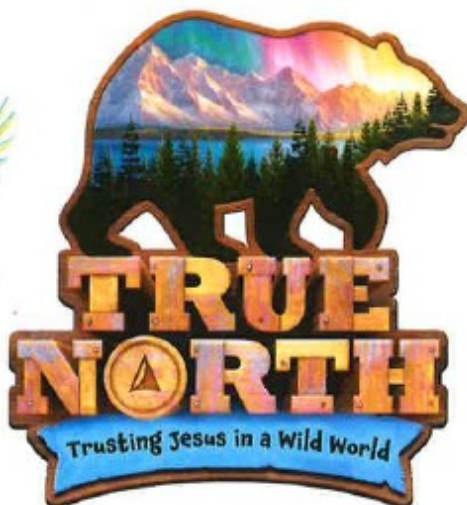
